Associate Professor Katie Allen (FRACP, PhD) is a Paediatric Gastroenterologist with a special clinical and research interest in food allergy who runs clinics in both the Dept of Gastroenterology and Department of Allergy and Immunology at the Royal Children's Hospital in Melbourne. She is also principal investigator of the HealthNuts study - a population based study of 5000 12 month old infants designed to investigate the prevalence of food allergy in Australia as well as to ascertain environmental and genetic predictors of food allergic disease. Her special clinical interests include Food allergy (IgE and non IgE), EE, FPIES and oro-facial granulomatosis. She is a full member of both AAAAI and ASCIA and sits on both the Paediatric and Education committees of the latter.
